

Pool Parties

The following is a standard policy for the use of the pool for parties. The Board has considered the option of allowing residents the option to rent out the pool for private use. There are pros and cons to allowing exclusive reservation of the pool, but that would limit residents from use during that time. We believe open access to all residents to the greatest extent possible is the most beneficial to the community.

All residents in good standing can use the pool to host a party under the following guidelines:

1. Rules - All current rules posted at the pool or on the website remain in full effect.
2. Guests - Residents are allowed 5 guests, whether there are lifeguards present or it is SAYOR. Any current Hayden Lakes residents with their own pool access card does not count against this limit. If lifeguards are not present, all residents must also have SAYOR access.
3. Lifeguards - More than 5 non-resident guests are permitted but there is a requirement to hire lifeguards through the pool management company. Current guidelines state one lifeguard for every 25 guests. This requirement is to ensure residents are not turned away due to guests filling up the pool. The pool management company is not required to supply lifeguards for private parties but may do so based on availability. Residents will not be restricted from using the pool, even if additional lifeguards are hired. All scheduling and payment of lifeguards is done through the pool management company.
4. Fee - There is no fee or deposit to use the pool for a party. Please remember to clean up when done.
5. Concessions - Food, drinks, cake, and decorations are all allowed. No glass.
6. Park - Between Nov 1 and March 1 the pool area and bathrooms are closed for the season. The playground is open year-round, and no reservation is needed. Tables and chairs of your own may be set up but will not be provided or moved from the pool pavilion.
