

Pool Privileges, Revocation and Fine Guidelines

Due to multiple incidents of unauthorized access to the pool, limited options to handle these, increased workload on the Board, and the liability it places on the Association, the Board has agreed to the following guidelines.

Accessing the pool without a properly functioning pool card is an Uncurable Violation in accordance with the Hayden Lakes Fine Policy and Schedule of Fines Section III.(b). Each resident or household will be levied a \$75 fine for the first offense, with pool access privileges suspended at the Board's discretion.

A second offense will incur a \$150 fine and access will be suspended for both guarded and SAYOR swim times for 30 days. A third offense will be a \$150 fine and 365-day suspension.

Access privileges are for an entire household or none of the household. If anyone in your family causes the loss of access, the entire family loses access. A suspension applies to both guarded and Swim At Your Own Risk privileges.

If there is any vandalism or damage to the property, there will be an additional \$100 fee plus the cost for cleanup, repairs, and/or replacement.

Any legal means of distributing images, including social media, may be used to identify and hold offenders accountable to limit the financial burden on the community.

These guidelines are in place to protect the Association's assets, ensure all incidents are treated the same, and deter unauthorized access with strict fines.
